25	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the		
26	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the		
27	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date		
28	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper		
29	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, ar		
30	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the		
31	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full		
32	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
