2	(C) Rules and regulations, together with any amendments thereto,			
3	which may from time to time be adopted by an authority for the regulation of			
4	operation and parking of motor vehicles shall be recorded in the official			
5	minutes of the authority board and shall be printed, with copies available as			
6	convenient locations in the terminal building.			
7	(D) Speed limits shall be posted at reasonable intervals, and			
8	traffic and parking directions and prohibitions shall be indicated by signs.			
9	(E) From and after the promulgation of the rules and regulations			
10	it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or to park a motor vehicle in

- (B) The tolls <u>and fees</u> may be charged and collected from vehicles accessing or departing from the airport, and the authority is empowered to make reasonable <u>tolls</u> and fees in accordance with industry standards and to make reasonable classifications of vehicles for this purpose.
- (C) The tolls <u>and fees</u> fixed by the authority shall not be subject to supervision or regulation by any other commission, board, bureau, or agency of the State of Arkansas;
- $\frac{(19)(A)}{(20)(A)}$ To levy and collect a tax in an amount not to exceed the maximum amount per passenger allowed by the federal government on the boarding or disembarking of aircraft at the airport or airports of the authority.
- (B) The tax shall be levied upon and collected from the passengers boarding or disembarking from the aircraft or the airlines operating the aircraft, and the authority is empowered to make reasonable classifications of passengers for this purpose;
- (20)(21) To receive real and personal property from the United States for airport and related purposes by donation, purchase, lease, or otherwise, and subject to such conditions and requirements relating thereto as the United States Government may require and to which the authority may agree;
- (21)(22) To apply to the proper authorities of the United States Government pursuant to appropriate law for the right to establish, operate, and maintain foreign trade zones within the area of jurisdiction of the member municipalities or counties, or both, and to establish, operate, and maintain those foreign trade zones;
- $\frac{(22)}{(23)}$ To promote, advertise, and publicize the authority and its facilities, to provide information to shippers, operators and other commercial interests, and to represent and promote the interests of the authority; and
- (23)(24) To take such other action, not inconsistent with law, as may be necessary or desirable to carry out the powers and authorities conferred by

5	(b)(1) Within one hundred twenty (120) one hundred fifty (150) days			
6	after the end of each fiscal year, each authority shall cause an annual audit			
7	to be made by an independent certified public accountant and shall file a copy			
8	of the resulting audit report with each of the governing bodies participating			
9	in the authority. This audit shall contain an itemized statement of its			
10	receipts and disbursements for the preceding year.
