10 COMMITTEE ON LEGISLATIVE FACILITIES FOR CONSTRUCTION,

12 ASSOCIATED COSTS OF LEGISLATIVE FACILITIES; AND FOR

16 AN ACT FOR THE JOINT INTERIM COMMITTEE

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE CENTRAL SERVICES FUND. There is hereby
25 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research Disbursing Officer, to be
26 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for construction,
27 reconstruction, renovations, remodeling, equipping and associated costs of
28 legislative facilities for the biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the sum
29 of \$350,000.
30

31 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - GENERAL IMPROVEMENT FUND. There is hereby
32 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research Disbursing Officer, to be
33 payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
34 accounts, for construction, reconstruction, renovations, remodeling, equipping
35 and associated costs of legislative facilities for the biennial period ending
36 June 30, 2003, the sum of..... \$400,000.

1 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE CENTRAL SERVICES FUND. There is hereby
2 appropriated, to the Bureau of Legislative Research Disbursing Officer, to be
3 payable from the State Central Services Fund, for renovations, construction,
4 interior maintenance, replace draperies and floor-coverings, electrical work,
5 repairs and other related services for the House of Representatives for the
6 biennial period ending June 30, 2003, the sum of\$350,000.
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8 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
10 LEGISLATIVE FACILITIES APPROVAL REQUIRED. None of the funds appropriated in
11 Sections 1 and 2 only, of this act shall be expended or committed unless prior
12 approval has been obtained from the Joint Committee on Legislative Facilities.
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14 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
21 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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23 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the
24 Eighty-third General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas
25 prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that
26 the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the
30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
