22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-34-107 is amended to read as follows:
25 25-34-107. Surplus equipment not sold.

26 (a)(1) Unsold surplus computer and electronic equipment may be donated
27 by the owning agency to Arkansas public schools if the agency policy so
28 provides.

29 (2) Arkansas public schools are not required but may choose to
30 accept unsold surplus computer and electronic equipment donated by the owning
31 agency.

32 (b)(1) Unsold surplus computer and electronic equipment may be donated
33 by the owning agency to law enforcement agencies if the agency policy so
34 provides.

35 (2) Law enforcement agencies are not required but may choose to
36 accept unsold surplus computer and electronic equipment donated by the owning



1 agency.

2 ~~(b)(1)(c)(1)~~ Unsold surplus computer equipment may be sent to the
3 Marketing and Redistribution Section of the Office of State Procurement of
4 the Department of Finance and Administration for sale, auction, recycling,
5 donation, demanufacturing, or disposal.

6 (2) Alternatively, the agency may maintain possession of
7 computers and electronics and allow the Marketing and Redistribution Section
8 to sell or auction the computer or electronic equipment via an Internet Web
9 site.
