## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REVISE CERTAIN PROVISIONS CONCERNING FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-284-109, concerning fire protection district assessments, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(c)(1) However, in cities of the first class that have two (2) or more full-time volunteer fire protection districts, the assessment is not final until reviewed by the governing body of the city and a resolution is passed that states the assessments have been reviewed.
(2) The city's governing body may return the assessments to the assessors with a request for further review of the assessments by the assessors.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-284-124(e), concerning the conditions and procedures for the consolidation of fire protection districts, is amended to read as follows:
(e) A consolidated fire protection district shall not have notes outstanding at any one (1) time in excess of one hundred thousand dollars

## (\$100,000).

(2) The limitation of the excess outstanding note balance under this subsection (e) shall not apply to a consolidation of fire protection districts in a city of the first class that had two (2) or more full-time volunteer fire protection districts that received funding from the city. /s/ Wood
