4	(2) "Concurrent enrollment course" means a college level course
5	or courses offered by an institution of higher education which upon
6	completion would qualify for academic credit in both the institution of

8	(3) "Pre-Advanced Placement course" means a middle school,
9	junior high school, or high school level course that specifically prepares
10	students to enroll and to participate in an advanced course.
11	(4) "Vertical team" means a group of educators from different
12	grade levels in a given discipline who work cooperatively to develop and
13	implement a vertically aligned program aimed at helping students from diverse
14	backgrounds acquire the academic skills necessary for success in the Advanced
15	Placement Program and other challenging coursework.

17	6-16-1203. Teacher training.
18	(a) A teacher of an Advanced Placement course must obtain appropriate
19	training.
20	(b)(1) The State Board of Education shall establish clear, specific,
21	and challenging training guidelines that require teachers of College Board
22	Advanced Placement courses and teachers of Pre-Advanced Placement courses to
23	obtain College Board sponsored or endorsed training.
24	(2) The training may include vertical team training.
25	
26	6-16-1204. Implementation of Advanced Placement courses.
27	(a) In order to prepare students for the rigor inherent in Advanced
28	Placement courses, school districts shall offer Pre-Advanced Placement
29	courses to prepare students for the demands of Advanced Placement coursework.
30	(b) The Department of Education shall:
31	(1) Approve all classes designated as Pre-Advanced Placement
32	courses; and
33	(2) Develop rules necessary for the implementation of Advanced
34	Placement courses.
35	(c) Beginning with the 2008-2009 school year, all school districts
36	shall offer one (1) College Board Advanced Placement course in each of the

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1	four (4) core areas of math, English, science, and social studies for a total
2	of four (4) courses.
3	(d)(1) The requirement under subsection (c) of this section shall be
4	phased in over a period of four (4) years beginning with the 2005-2006 school

11	6-16-1205. Concurrent Enrollment Course Approval Panel.
12	(a) There is established a panel to be known as the "Concurrent
13	Enrollment Course Approval Panel".
14	(b) The panel shall consist of six (6) members as follows:
15	(1) Three (3) persons appointed by the Director of the Department
16	of Education; and
17	(2) Three (3) persons appointed by the Director of the
18	Department of Higher Education.
19	(c) The appointed panel members shall be:
20	(1) Knowledgeable regarding advanced placement coursework or
21	concurrent enrollment coursework; and
22	(2) Residents of the State of Arkansas at the time of
23	appointment and throughout his or her term.
24	(d) Members shall serve at the pleasure of the director making his or
25	her appointment.
26 2 <b>-</b>	(e) If a vacancy occurs in an appointed position, for any reason, the
27	vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the director of the department that
28	made the original appointment.
29	(f)(1) A member of the panel appointed by the Director of the
30	Department of Education and the Department of Higher Education shall
31	alternate serving as chairperson of the panel each year.
32	(2) The Director of the Department of Education and the
33 34	Department of Higher Education shall alternate each year naming a person to serve as chairperson of the panel.
35	(3) The Director of the Department of Education and the
36	Department of Higher Education shall draw lots to determine which director

2	(g)(1) The panel shall meet at times and places the chairperson deems		
3	necessary, but no meetings shall be held outside of the State of Arkansas.		
4	(2) A majority of the members of the panel shall constitute a		
5	quorum for the purpose of transacting business.		
6	(3) All action of the panel shall be by a majority vote of the		
7	full membership of the panel.		
8	(h) For the purpose of access and equity, the panel shall make		
9	recommendations to the Department of Education and the Department of Higher		
10	Education regarding the rules for offering of Advance Placement courses or		
11	concurrent enrollment courses, or both.		
12	(i) The Department of Higher Education and the Department of Education		
13	may jointly promulgate rules for offering of Advance Placement courses or		
14	concurrent enrollment courses, or both based upon the recommendations of the		
15	panel.		
16	(j)(l) The Department of Higher Education shall provide staff and		
17	office space to the panel.		
18	(2)(A) Members of the panel shall serve without pay.		
19	(B) Members of the panel may receive expense reimbursement		
20	in accordance with Arkansas Code § 25-16-902, to be paid by the Department of		
21	Higher Education to the extent money is available.		
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23	6-16-1206. Exemption.		
24	Any high school offering the International Baccalaureate Diploma		
25	Program shall be exempt from the provisions of this subchapter.
