9	funds are available; and that the expenses of the Arkansas District Judge
10	Retirement System are a just expense of the state that must be paid.
11	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
12	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
13	become effective on:
14	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
15	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
16	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the

18	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
