21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-51-104(a), concerning the Arkansas State
24 Council for the Interstate Commission for Adult Offender Supervision, is
25 amended to read as follows:

26 (a) An Arkansas State Council for the Interstate Commission for Adult
27 Offender Supervision is created, which shall consist of the following
28 members:

29 (1) ~~One (1) nonelected representative of the legislative branch~~
30 ~~of government appointed by the General Assembly pursuant to a process~~
31 ~~determined by the Joint Rules Committee~~ One (1) nonelected person, chosen
32 from a list of five (5) names submitted by the Director of the Department of
33 Community Correction, who will act as the representative of the legislative
34 branch of government, to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the
35 Senate;



1 (2) One (1) representative of the judicial branch of government,
2 who is not an acting judge, appointed by the Governor;

3 (3) The members of the Board of Corrections, who will act as
4 representatives of the executive branch of government, appointed by the
5 Governor;

6 (4) One (1) representative from a victims group appointed by the
7 Governor; and

8 (5) The Director of the Department of Community Correction who,
9 in addition to serving as a member of the council, shall be appointed by the
10 Governor as the compact administrator for the state.
