25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 2 is amended
26	to add an additional section to read as follows:
27	6-60-212. Admissions — Applicants from medically underserved areas.
28	(a) In an effort to address health disparities and the current
29	shortage of nursing professionals in the state, each board of trustees of a
30	publicly supported institution of higher education may establish a program
31	under which additional consideration in admission to the institution and to
32	the nursing or health career program is given to an applicant from a rural,
33	medically underserved area of the state who is interested in pursuing a
34	nursing or other health care career in a rural, medically underserved area of
35	the state.



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1	(b) The program for additional consideration under subsection (a) of
2	this section may include, without limitation, the following measures:
3	(1) Early targeting of potential candidates from rural,
4	medically underserved areas of the state who are interested in nursing and
5	other health care professions, including junior high school, high school,
6	two-year college, and four-year college students;
7	(2) Recruitment and guidance of individuals from rural,
8	medically underserved areas of the state who are interested in pursuing
9	nursing and other health care professions in rural, medically underserved
10	areas;
11	(3) Offering programs to prepare identified nursing and other
12	health career candidates from rural, medically underserved areas of the state
13	for meeting admission requirements to a postsecondary nursing program,
14	including, without limitation, preparatory programs offered with the aid of
15	video and distance learning tools; and
16	(4) Providing that individuals from a rural, medically
17	underserved area of the state who are interested in a nursing or other health
18	care profession receive an equal opportunity for success.

27	to add an additional section to read as follows:
28	17-87-403. Nursing recruitment and admission.
29	Upon request, the Arkansas State Board of Nursing shall provide
30	assistance to publicly supported institutions of higher education in
31	implementing programs offered under § 6-60-212.
