3	(c) The commission shall meet on a regular basis and shall make
4	recommendations to the House Interim Committee on Education and the Senate
5	Interim Committee on Education by August 1 of the year preceding the year in
6	which the regular session of the General Assembly is held regarding the
7	performance and coordination of the state's program of distance learning.
8	(d) Staff support shall be provided by the appropriate personnel from
9	the Department of Education, the state's public institutions of higher
10	education, the Department of Higher Education, and the Department of
11	Workforce Education with the assistance of any appropriate staff of the other
12	agencies whose directors serve on the commission.
13	(a) There is created an advisory body to the Department of Education
14	to be known as the 'Distance Learning Coordinating Council'.
15	(b) The purpose of the coordinating council is to evaluate distance
16	learning activities for grades kindergarten through twelve (K-12) education
17	across the State of Arkansas and determine if distance learning activities
18	are being fully utilized through a collaborative process that maximizes the
19	utilization of the state's technical and educational resources.
20	(c) The coordinating council shall consist of the following members:
21	(1) One (1) member who is an employee of the Department of
22	Education appointed by the Director of the Department of Education;
23	(2) One (1) member who is an employee of the Arkansas
24	Educational Television Network appointed by the Director of the Division of
25	Educational Television;
26	(3) One (1) member who is an employee of the Arkansas School for
27	Mathematics, Science and the Arts appointed by the director of the school;
28	(4) One (1) member who is an employee of Office of Information
29	Technology appointed by the Director of the Office of Information Technology,
30	(5) One (1) member who is an employee of the Department of

12	(12) Two (2) members who are employed by telecommunications
13	companies that are members of the Arkansas Telecommunications Association and
14	appointed as follows:
15	(A) One (1) member shall be employed by a
16	telecommunications company with more than seventy-five thousand (75,000)
17	access lines and shall be appointed by the Governor from a list of three (3)
18	names submitted by the Arkansas Telecommunications Association; and
19	(B) One (1) member shall be employed by a
20	telecommunications company with less than seventy-five thousand (75,000)

32	organize immediately after their appointment and shall elect a chair, a vice
33	chair, and a secretary-treasurer from the membership of the coordinating
34	council.
35	(4) The coordinating council shall meet at least quarterly.

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27	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
28	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas Supreme Court has
29	determined that current public school academic facilities in the State of
30	Arkansas are inadequate and inequitable; that the General Assembly
31	established the Joint Committee on Educational Facilities to inventory the
32	current condition of school facilities and recommend methods for bringing
33	those facilities into conformity with the court's constitutional
34	expectations; that one of the recommendations of the joint committee is to
35	establish a new advisory body to evaluate distance learning capabilities in
36	the public schools; that the establishment of the Distance Learning

1	Coordinating Council satisfies the recommendations of the joint committee;
2	and that in order to promote the state's efforts to satisfy constitutional
3	expectations with regard to an adequate education, the new coordinating
4	council needs to begin work with the fiscal year beginning July, 2005.
5	Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately
6	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
7	become effective on July 1, 2005.
