AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT SURVEYS AND PLATS ARE NOT
SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR RECORDING
INSTRUMENTS WITH THE CIRCUIT CLERK; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT SURVEYS AND PLATS ARE
NOT SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR
RECORDING INSTRUMENTS WITH THE CIRCUIT
CLERK.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-15-402(b), concerning instruments
24 recorded with the circuit clerk, is amended to read as follows:

25 (b)(1) To be accepted by the recorder for recording purposes, all
26 documents shall:

27 (A) Be on 8 1/2" by 11" paper;

28 (B) Have a two and one-half inch (2 1/2") margin at the
29 right top of the first page, a one-half inch (1/2") margin on the sides and
30 bottom of all pages, and a two and one-half inch (2 1/2") margin at the
31 bottom of the last page;

32 (C) Have an area reserved on the top right of the first
33 page for the file mark of the recorder;

34 (D) Contain the following information:

35 (i) The title of the document; and



1 (ii) The name of the grantor and grantee, where
2 applicable;

3 (E) Be acknowledged in accordance with § 16-47-207; and

4 (F) Be legible.

5 (2)(A) The recorder shall have the discretion to waive the
6 requirements of subdivision (b)(1) of this section for good cause.

7 (B) All ~~surveys, plats,~~ documents, and instruments
8 executed before January 1, 2004, shall be exempt from the requirements of
9 subdivision (b)(1) of this section.

10 (C) All surveys and plats shall be exempt from the
11 requirements of subdivision (b)(1) of this section.
