9 AN ACT TO ADD THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF  
10 CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF  
11 HUMAN SERVICES TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE  
12 CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT PREVENTION BOARD; AND FOR  
13 OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 AN ACT TO ADD THE DIRECTOR OF THE  
16 DIVISION OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES  
17 TO THE STATE CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT  
18 PREVENTION BOARD.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 9-30-104 (b) and (c), concerning the  
25 membership of the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, are amended  
26 to read as follows:

27 (b) The board shall be composed of nine (9) members appointed by the  
28 Governor, one (1) from each of the present four (4) congressional districts,  
29 the Director of the Division of Children and Family Services of the  
30 Department of Human Services or his or her designee, and ~~five (5)~~ four (4)  
31 from the state at-large. However, no more than three (3) members of the board  
32 shall reside in the same congressional district. As a group, the members  
33 shall demonstrate knowledge in the area of child abuse and neglect  
34 prevention, and to the extent practicable shall be representative of the  
35 professional providers of child abuse and neglect prevention services,



1 volunteers in child abuse and neglect prevention services, and providers of  
2 domestic violence programs.

3 (c)(1) The term of each member shall be three (3) years with the  
4 exception of the position designated for the Director of the Division of  
5 Children and Family Services of the Department of Human Services.

6 (2) A member shall not serve more than two (2) consecutive  
7 terms, whether partial or full.

8 (3) A vacancy shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired  
9 term in the same manner as the original appointment.
