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20	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
21	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a need for the law to
22	include other facilities and buildings in the definition of "capital
23	improvements of a public nature" and vehicles in the definition of
24	"facilities" to provide the means for cities to accomplish needed municipal
25	projects; that this act is necessary to correct deficiencies in the law; and
26	that this act is immediately necessary because cities need the ability to
27	begin the steps necessary to accomplish municipal projects. Therefore, an
28	emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
29	the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become
30	effective on:
31	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
32	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
33	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
34	bill; or
35	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
36	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
