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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 1, Subchapter 1, is amended
27 to add a new section as follows:

28 6-1-105. Information sharing with the Assessment Coordination
29 Department.

30 (a)(1) The State Board of Education, the Department of Education, and
31 any other department or division administered by the board shall provide
32 information maintained by the board, Department of Education, or other
33 department or division to the Assessment Coordination Department upon
34 request by the Assessment Coordination Department.

35 (2) The information shall enable the Assessment Coordination



1 Department to:

2 (A) Verify, ascertain, or calculate assessed values of
3 real and personal property, millage rates, or tax collection rates in school
4 districts and counties; and

5 (B) Assist the General Assembly, the Attorney General, or
6 another state agency in verifying, ascertaining, or calculating data related
7 to public schools, including school funding, school district revenues, and
8 public school facilities.

9 (b) Information provided under this section shall be in any medium in
10 which the record is readily available or in any format to which it is readily
11 convertible with the existing software used by the board, Department of
12 Education or other department or division.

13 (c) Actual costs or expenses incurred in compiling or transmitting the
14 data to the Assessment Coordination Department shall be paid by the
15 Department of Education.
