8 SECTION 160. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 161. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 18 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 20 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 162. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 28 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Constitution of the State of 29 Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year 30 period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are 31 32 provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the 33 delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential 34 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist 35 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 36

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
