AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER FOR STATE ASSISTANCE TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN HOWARD AND SEVIER COUNTIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER - STATE ASSISTANCE TO FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN HOWARD AND SEVIER COUNTIES GENERAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS - HOWARD COUNTY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For state assistance to the Nashville Volunteer Fire Department, the sum of\$8,000.

(B) For state assistance to the Cotton Shed Volunteer Fire Department, the sum of\$8,000.

(C) For state assistance to the Saratoga Volunteer Fire Department, the



1 sum of\$8,000.

2 (D) For state assistance to the County Line Volunteer Fire Department, the
3 sum of\$8,000.

4 (E) For state assistance to the Mineral Springs Volunteer Fire Department,
5 the sum of\$8,000.

6 (F) For state assistance to the Tollett Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
7 of\$8,000.

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9 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS - SEVIER COUNTY. There is
10 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -
11 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its
12 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

13 (A) For state assistance to the Provo Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
14 of\$8,000.

15 (B) For state assistance to the Green's Chapel Volunteer Fire Department,
16 the sum of\$8,000.

17 (C) For state assistance to the Lockesburg Volunteer Fire Department, the
18 sum of\$8,000.

19 (D) For state assistance to the Cossatot Volunteer Fire Department, the
20 sum of\$8,000.

21 (E) For state assistance to the De Queen Volunteer Fire Department, the
22 sum of\$8,000.

23 (F) For state assistance to the Gillham Volunteer Fire Department, the sum
24 of\$8,000.

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26 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
27 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
28 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
29 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
30 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
31 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
32 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
33 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
34 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
35 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
36 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall

1 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

2 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
3 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
4 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
5 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
6 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
7 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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9 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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18 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
20 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
