21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-359-104(a), concerning the number of
24	members on a municipal airport commission, is amended to read as follows:
25	(a) (l) Any city with a population of less than one hundred fifty
26	thousand (150,000) affected by and desiring to avail itself of the benefits
27	of this chapter shall, by a majority vote of the elected and qualified
28	members of its city council, enact an ordinance creating an airport
29	commission to be composed of seven (7) citizens who are qualified electors of
30	the state.
31	(2) Any city with a population of at least one hundred fifty
32	thousand (150,000) affected by and desiring to avail itself of the benefits
33	of this chapter shall, by a majority vote of the elected and qualified
34	members of its city council, enact an ordinance creating an airport
35	commission to be composed of five (5) citizens who are qualified electors of

1	the state. At least one (1) of the five (5) members shall be fully
2	experienced in aviation, holding some type of pilot aeronautical rating.
3	
4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-359-105, concerning the composition of a
5	municipal airport commission, is amended to add a new subsection to read as
6	follows:
7	(e) For municipal airport commissions with five (5) members in
8	existence on the effective date of this subsection (e), the initial terms of
9	the two (2) new members shall be as follows:
10	(1) One (1) new member shall serve an initial term of four (4)
11	years; and
12	(2) One (1) new member shall serve an initial term of five (5)
13	years.
14	
15	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
16	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that membership of a municipal
17	airport commission in larger Arkansas cities is unnecessarily restricted;
18	that increasing the number of commission members to that of commissions in
19	smaller cities will better equip the commission to address the needs of the
20	municipal airports; and that this act is immediately necessary in order to
21	permit municipal airport commissions to begin the process of selecting
22	additional members. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act
23	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health,
24	and safety shall become effective on:
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
28	bill; or
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
