General Assembly must guarantee the provision of adequate academic

1	facilities; and that the continued existence of the Commission for Arkansas

3	its efforts to guarantee adequate academic facilities for students throughout			
4	the state. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being			
5	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall

8	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,			
9	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the			
10	bill; or
