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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-7-123(b)(1), concerning fees for vital
26 records, is amended to read as follows:

27 (b) These fees are as follows:

28 (1) All fees prescribed in the Vital Statistics Act, § 20-18-101
29 et seq., which are as follows:

30 (A) A fee of ~~two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50)~~ fifteen
31 dollars (\$15.00) collected by the State Registrar of Vital Records for the
32 filing of a delayed certificate of birth;

33 (B) A fee of ~~two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50)~~ fifteen
34 dollars (\$15.00) collected by the state registrar for the filing of a delayed
35 certificate of death or marriage;

2 ~~(L) After June 30, 2003, the fee provisions as set forth in~~
3 ~~this subdivision (b)(1) shall revert to those fees allowed prior to August~~

5 (2)(A) A fee, ~~as determined pursuant to this subdivision (b)(2),~~
6 to be collected for the review of plans and specifications covering
7 improvements ~~which that,~~ by law or regulation, are required to be reviewed by
8 the State Board of Health or the Division of Health of the Department of
9 Health and Human Services, ~~or any law or regulation amendatory thereof or~~
10 ~~supplementary thereto,~~ including, without limitation, plans and
11 specifications covering waterworks, sewage works, swimming pools, hospitals
12 and related facilities, food service and food processing establishments, and
13 plumbing in public facilities.

14 (B) The fee imposed under subdivision (b)(2)(A) of this
15 section shall be one percent (1%) of the estimated cost, with a maximum fee
16 of five hundred dollars (\$500) and a minimum fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00),
17 calculated and paid on the basis of the engineering estimate of the total
18 cost of the particular improvement, which estimate is to be submitted with
19 the plans and specifications for review.

20 (C) If the maximum fee of five hundred dollars (\$500) is
21 paid, no engineering estimate of the total cost need be submitted with the
22 plans and specifications, and

23 (3) A fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) to be collected by the board
24 or the department for each cemetery inspection as required by law or
25 regulation, ~~or any law or regulation amendatory thereof or supplementary~~
26 ~~thereto.~~
