There is hereby authorized, for the 24 Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of 25 26 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from 27 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5) temporary or part-time 28 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the 29 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act 30 for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 5 AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education - Division of Public 6 School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the approval of the Chief 7 Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas Legislative 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to request necessary 9 appropriation transfers and any other budget related adjustments necessary 10 for the appropriations authorized herein. Furthermore, it is the intent of 11 the General Assembly that the Department of Education - Division of Public 12 School Academic Facilities and Transportation be able to make use of 13 additional contractual services as necessary and that transfers between line 14 items and among appropriations are anticipated to accomplish those purposes. 15 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 16 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 17 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 18 19 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 20 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 21 has determined that the Department of Education - Division of Public School 22 Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some 23 flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education -24 Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing 25 broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is 26 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight 27 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 28 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the 29 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this 30 section. If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent 31 32 jurisdiction, this entire section is void. 33 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005

34 <u>2007</u> through June 30, 2007 <u>2009</u>.

36 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 2 FORWARD. The balance of the appropriations as provided in Section 4 of this Act for grants and aid and special programs providing academic school 3 4 facility and transportation assistance to the public school district for 5 Programs of the Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 6 Transportation which remain on June 30, 2006 2008, shall be carried forward 7 and made available for the same purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, 8 2007 2009. 9 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as 10 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions: 11 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set 12 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget; 13 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall 14 15 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from 16 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the 17 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which 18 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution 19 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the 20 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item, 21 22 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request 23 set forth in (1) above; 24 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written 25 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 26 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written 27 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for 28 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents 29 30 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget 31 Committee; and 32 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include 33 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals 34 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or 35 Institution. 36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005

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2007 through June 30, 2007 2009. 2 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 3 4 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 6 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 12 13 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 14 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 18 19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 20 21 22 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 24 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 27 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 28 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 29 30 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 31 32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007. 33 34 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 35 36 APPROVED: 4/5/2007
