12 CLERK-TREASURERS, RECORDER-TREASURERS, AND
13 TREASURERS IN CITIES OF THE FIRST CLASS AND
14 CITIES OF THE SECOND CLASS WHO RETIRE UNDER
15 *STATE-AUTHORIZED LOCAL PLANS UNDER CERTAIN*

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-12-121(a), concerning retirement
27 benefits, is amended to read as follows:

28 ~~(a) Any city clerk or clerk-treasurer in a city of the first class who~~
29 ~~shall have served as city clerk, clerk-treasurer, and city treasurer for a~~
30 ~~period of not less than ten (10) years, upon reaching the age of sixty (60),~~
31 ~~or who shall serve twenty (20) years without regard to age, shall be entitled~~
32 ~~to retire from office for the remainder of his or her life at the retirement~~
33 ~~pay provided for in this section.~~

34 (a)(1) A city clerk or clerk-treasurer in a city of the first class
35 may retire from office for the remainder of his or her life at the retirement



1 pay provided in this section if the person has served as city clerk, clerk-
2 treasurer, or city treasurer for:

3 (A) Not less than ten (10) years, upon reaching sixty (60)
4 years of age; or

5 (B) Twenty (20) years, without regard to age.

6 (2) On January 1 of each year, if a retiree under this section
7 has been retired for at least twelve (12) full months, up to a three percent
8 (3%) cost-of-living increase will be added.

9 (3) Subdivision (a)(2) of this section applies only if approved
10 by the governing body of the city.

11
12 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-12-123(a), concerning cost-of-living
13 increases, is amended to add the following subdivisions:

14 (5) On January 1 of each year, if a retiree under this section
15 has been retired for at least twelve (12) full months, up to a three percent
16 (3%) cost-of-living increase will be added.

17 (6) Subdivision (a)(5) of this section applies only if approved
18 by the governing body of the city.

19
20 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-12-124(a), concerning cost-of-living
21 increases, is amended to read as follows:

22 ~~(a)(1) Persons who have served as mayors of cities~~ A person who has
23 served as mayor of a city of the second class for at least twenty (20) years
24 may retire at any age, and ~~persons who have served as mayors of cities~~ a
25 person who has served as a mayor of a city of the second class for at least
26 sixteen (16) years may retire upon reaching ~~age~~ sixty-five (65) years of age.

27 (2) On January 1 of each year, if a retiree under this section
28 has been retired for at least twelve (12) full months, up to a three percent
29 (3%) cost-of-living increase will be added.

30 (3) Subdivision (a)(2) of this section applies only if approved
31 by the governing body of the city.

32
33 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 24-12-127(a), concerning cost-of-living
34 increases, is amended to read as follows:

35 (a)(1) Any recorder-treasurers and city treasurers in a city of the
36 second class who shall have served as recorder-treasurer and city treasurer

1 for a period of not less than ten (10) years, upon reaching the age of sixty
2 (60), or who shall serve twenty (20) years without regard to age, may, upon a
3 vote of approval by the governing body of the city, retire from office for
4 the remainder of his or her life at the retirement pay provided for in this
5 section.

6 (2) On January 1 of each year, if a retiree under this section
7 has been retired for at least twelve (12) full months, up to a three percent
8 (3%) cost-of-living increase will be added.

9 (3) Subdivision (a)(2) of this section applies only if approved
10 by the governing body of the city.
