21 **For An Act To Be Entitled**

22 AN ACT TO CREATE THE UAMS CANCER RESEARCH CENTER  
23 MATCHING FUND; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

25 **Subtitle**

26 AN ACT TO CREATE THE UAMS CANCER  
27 RESEARCH CENTER MATCHING FUND.

30 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

32 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12 is amended  
33 to add an additional section to read as follows:

34 19-5-1230. UAMS Cancer Research Center Matching Fund.

35 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the



1 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a miscellaneous  
2 fund to be known as the "UAMS Cancer Research Center Matching Fund".

3 (b) The fund shall consist of such revenue as may be authorized by  
4 law.

5 (c) The fund shall be used as matching funds for the construction of  
6 and endowments for the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences Cancer  
7 Research Center.

8 (d)(1) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall release funds to  
9 the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences on a matching basis in an  
10 amount equal to the amount of grants and donations received as cash, cash  
11 equivalent, or an in-kind property pledge enforced by a binding written  
12 agreement. The period for which grants and donations shall be counted for  
13 matching purposes shall be January 1, 2007, through June 30, 2009.

14 (2) The release of the funds shall be upon documentation  
15 demonstrating that the matching requirement has been met. The documentation  
16 shall be signed by the Chancellor of the University of Arkansas for Medical  
17 Sciences.

18 (3) Requests for the release of funds may be made on a quarterly  
19 basis, and pending a favorable review of the documentation by the Chief  
20 Fiscal Officer of the State, payments shall be made in the first month  
21 following the request.

22  
23 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
24 Assembly that the effectiveness of this act on July 1, 2007, is essential  
25 because an appropriation will be made for the fund created by this act and  
26 the appropriation will become effective on July 1, 2007; and that a delay in  
27 the effective date of this act beyond July 1, 2007, could work irreparable  
28 harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being  
30 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and  
31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
