31	SECTION 2. The funds received by SAU-Tech as authorized by Act 2315 of the

1	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1029 of 2005 enacted an
3	appropriation to assist SAU-Tech construction and Act 2315 of 2005 authorized
4	funding to assist SAU-Tech construction; that since the passage of these
5	acts, it has become apparent that the air conditioning and other pertinent
6	mechanical systems of SAU-Tech require repair; and that the performance of
7	critical maintenance on these systems is critical for the continued operation
8	and support of SAU-Tech. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
9	and this act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
11	date of its passage and approval.
12	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
13	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
14	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
15	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
16	the veto.
