11 FAIR AND LIVESTOCK SHOW ASSOCIATION; AND FOR  
12 OTHER PURPOSES.

15 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE  
16 ARKANSAS STATE FAIR AND LIVESTOCK SHOW  
17 ASSOCIATION.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21  
22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-171-215(a)(7), concerning funding for the  
23 Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show Association, is amended to read as  
24 follows:

25 (7) The Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show Association or  
26 its bond trustee shall receive the moneys listed in this subdivision (a)(7),  
27 less any general revenues appropriated to the State Fair:

28 (A) Eight hundred eighty-seven thousand nine hundred eight  
29 dollars (\$887,908) in the fiscal year 2001;

30 (B) No moneys under this subdivision (a)(7)(B) in the  
31 fiscal year 2002;

32 (C) No moneys under this subdivision (a)(7)(C) in the  
33 fiscal year 2003;

34 (D) Eight hundred eighty-seven thousand nine hundred eight  
35 dollars (\$887,908) in the fiscal year 2004;

 14 eight dollars (\$532,748) in the fiscal year 2011;

15 (L) Four hundred forty-three thousand nine hundred fifty-  
 16 eight dollars (\$443,958) in the fiscal year 2012;

17 (M) Three hundred fifty-five thousand one hundred sixty-  
 18 eight dollars (\$355,168) in the fiscal year 2013;

19 (N) Two hundred sixty-six thousand three hundred seventy-  
 20 eight dollars (\$266,378) in the fiscal year 2014;

21 (O) One hundred seventy-seven thousand five hundred  
 22 eighty-eight dollars (\$177,588) in the fiscal year 2015; and

23 (P) Eighty-eight thousand seven hundred ninety-eight  
 24 dollars (\$88,798) in the fiscal year 2016;

 26 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
 27 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that funds provided by the General  
 28 Assembly for the operation of the Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show  
 29 Association are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the  
 30 Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show Association to continue to provide  
 31 essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide  
 32 the necessary moneys for the Arkansas State Fair and Livestock Show  
 33 Association to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date  
 34 of this act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
 35 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
 36 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the

1 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective  
2 on:

3 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

4 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the  
5 expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill;  
6 or

7 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden,  
8 the date the last house overrides the veto.
