10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE
11 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION - OFFICE
12 OF CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT FOR THE BIENNIAL
13 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2009; AND FOR OTHER
14 PURPOSES.

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18 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
19 AND ADMINISTRATION - OFFICE OF CHILD
20 SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT APPROPRIATION FOR
21 THE 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
27 Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support
28 Enforcement for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of
29 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
31 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
32 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
33 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
34 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
35 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular

 2 successor.

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15 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of
 16 Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support Enforcement for the
 17 2007-2009 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary
 18 employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated
 19 herein for such purposes: fifteen (15) temporary or part-time employees,
 20 when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform
 21 Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the
 22 appropriate classification.

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24 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 25 the Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support
 26 Enforcement, to be payable from the Child Support Enforcement Fund, for
 27 personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Finance and
 28 Administration - Office of Child Support Enforcement - Operations for the
 29 biennial period ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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9 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA
 11 HELP EXEMPTION. Extra Help positions authorized herein are specifically
 12 exempt from limitation of hours, either by act or regulation. Provided,
 13 however, when a temporary or part-time employee is employed by the Department
 14 of Finance and Administration - Office of Child Support Enforcement for a
 15 period of time exceeding seven (7) months, a report of such shall be filed
 16 with the Legislative Council. The provisions of this section shall be in
 17 effect only from July 1, ~~2005~~ 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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19 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DATA
 21 PROCESSING AND EQUIPMENT EXPENSES - CARRY FORWARD PROVISION. The unexpended
 22 balances in the appropriation provided for Data Processing and Equipment
 23 Expenses which remain on June 30, 2008, shall be made available and used for
 24 the same purpose during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009. A report of
 25 such balances carried forward will be made to the Legislative Council or the
 26 Joint Budget Committee.
 27 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as
 28 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:
 29 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth
 30 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding
 31 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
 32 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
 33 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from
 34 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the
 35 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
 36 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which

1 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
 2 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the
 3 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,
 4 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request
 5 set forth in (1) above;

6 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
 7 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 8 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
 9 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
 10 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
 11 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
 12 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 13 Committee; and

14 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
 15 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
 16 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
 17 Institution.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
 19 through June 30, 2009.

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 21 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 22 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 23 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 24 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 25 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 26 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 27 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 28 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 29 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 31 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 32 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 33 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 34 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 35 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

1 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
2 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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4 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
5 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
6 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
7 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
8 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
10 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
11 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
12 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
13 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
14 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
