18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
19

20 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-58-306, concerning disposal of municipal*
21 *supplies, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:*

22 *(c)(1) If an item of personal property belonging to a municipality*
23 *becomes obsolete or is no longer used by a municipality, it may be:*

24 *(A) Sold at public auction;*

25 *(B) Sent to the Marketing and Redistribution Section of*
26 *the Office of State Procurement of the Department of Finance and*
27 *Administration; or*

28 *(C) Transferred to another governmental entity within the*
29 *state.*

30 *(2) If an item is not disposed of under subsection (c) of this*
31 *section, the item may be disposed of in the landfill used by the municipality*
32 *if the mayor or his or her authorized representative certifies in writing and*
33 *the governing body of the municipality approves that it has:*

34 *(A) Been rendered worthless by damage or prolonged use; or*

35 *(B)(i) Only residual value; and*
