17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-16-903 is amended to read as follows:

21 Each of the following state boards, by a majority vote of the total  
22 membership of the board cast during its first regularly scheduled meeting of  
23 each calendar year, may authorize payment to its members of a stipend not to  
24 exceed sixty dollars (\$60.00) per ~~meeting attended~~ day for each meeting,  
25 examination, evaluation, or inspection attended or for any day while  
26 performing any proper business of the board, and the board members shall  
27 receive no other compensation, expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of payments  
28 except as provided in § 25-16-902:

3 meeting, examination, evaluation, or inspection attended or for any day while  
4 performing any proper business of the board, and the board members shall  
5 receive no other compensation, expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of payments  
6 except as provided in § 25-16-902:

 3 each calendar year, may authorize payment to its members of a stipend not to  
 4 exceed one hundred ten dollars (\$110) per ~~meeting,~~ day for each meeting,  
 5 examination, evaluation, or ~~inspections~~ inspection attended or for any day  
 6 while performing any proper business of the board, and the board members  
 7 shall receive no other compensation, expense reimbursement, or in-lieu-of  
 8 payments except as provided in § 25-16-902:

- 10 (2) Arkansas State Medical Board;
- 11 (3) State Board of Optometry;
- 12 (4) Sex Offenders Assessment Committee;
