AN ACT TO STREAMLINE THE PROCESS FOR ARKANSAS NONTRADITIONAL LICENSURE

CERTIFICATION FOR TEACHERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-409, concerning nontraditional licensure certification, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:
(d) If the Department of Education requires an applicant for nontraditional licensure certification to complete one (l) or more additional college-level courses and the applicant has obtained a bachelor's degree, the required course or courses shall meet one (l) or more of the following conditions:
(1)(A) Each course shall be offered at every state-supported two-year institution of higher education.
(B) If more than one (1) course is required, all courses shall be offered in a one-semester block; or
(2) Each course shall be available as an online course, a
traditional face-to-face course, or a hybrid course that is part online
instruction and part face-to-face instruction, as approved by the department. /s/ Bisbee
