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11	SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the			
12	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act transfers the			
13	Division of Land Surveys in the Office of Commissioner of State Lands to the			
14	Arkansas Agriculture Department; that to effectively administer this act the			
15	transition should occur at the beginning of the next fiscal year; and that			
16	the effectiveness of this act on July 1, 2007, is essential to the operation			
17	of the agencies. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act			
18	being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety			
19	shall become effective on July 1, 2007.
