23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Board		
26	of Hearing Instrument Dispensers for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following		
27	maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra		
28	Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one (1)

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SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEASING FROM ARKANSAS BUILDING AUTHORITY. The Board of Hearing Instrument Dispensers shall be exempt from Arkansas Building Authority leasing jurisdiction and procedures as set out in Arkansas Code 22-2-114.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,
23 <u>2005</u> <u>2007</u> through June 30, <u>2007</u> <u>2009</u>.

25 SECTION 4. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 26 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 27 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 28 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 29 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the 30 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the 31 32 requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the 33 agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend 34 monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if: 35 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such 36 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

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1 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the 2 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.

9 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 12 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 14 15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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19 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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28 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of 31 32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 36
