16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS DEVELOPMENT  
17 FINANCE AUTHORITY APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
18 2007-2009 BIENNIUM.

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas  
25 Development Finance Authority for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

32 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas  
33 Development Finance Authority for the 2007-2009 biennium, the following  
34 maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra  
35 Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: five (5)  
36 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed

1 those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its  
2 successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
5 appropriated, to the Arkansas Development Finance Authority, to be payable  
6 from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Arkansas  
7 Development Finance Authority, for personal services and operating expenses  
8 of the Arkansas Development Finance Authority for the biennial period ending  
9 June 30, 2009, the following:

27 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY  
29 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of the appropriation authorized in the HUD  
30 Home Program of this Act which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending  
31 June 30, ~~2006~~ 2008 shall be carried forward and made available for the same  
32 purpose for the fiscal year ended June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

33 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of appropriation and/or funding as  
34 authorized herein, may be carried forward under the following conditions:

35  
36 (1) Prior to June 30, 2008 the Agency shall by written statement set forth

1 its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said appropriation and/or funding  
2 to the Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

3 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall  
4 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward from  
5 the first fiscal year of the biennium to the second fiscal year of the  
6 biennium by the September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget  
7 Committee meeting in the second fiscal year of the biennial period which  
8 report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution  
9 and the amount of the appropriation and/or funding carried forward from the  
10 first fiscal year to the second fiscal year, the program name or line item,  
11 the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the written request  
12 set forth in (1) above;

13 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written  
14 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
15 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written  
16 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for  
17 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)  
18 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents  
19 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget  
20 Committee; and

21 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include  
22 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals  
23 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or  
24 Institution.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005  
26 2007 through June 30, 2007 2009.

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28 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUD HOME  
30 PROGRAM DISBURSEMENTS. The disbursement of funds appropriated in the HUD Home  
31 Program of this Act shall be in accordance with the State of Arkansas  
32 Consolidated Plan developed and administered in part by the Arkansas  
33 Development Finance Authority and shall be in accordance with project  
34 requirements and regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban  
35 Development HOME Program.

36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005

1 2007 through June 30, ~~2007~~ 2009.

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3 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
4 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
5 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
6 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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13 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
14 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
18 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
20 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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22 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
24 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of  
26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
27 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
28 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the  
29 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
30 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
31 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
32 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
