OVERTIME. 3 4 The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to pay overtime to its employees, and the administration thereof shall be in accordance with the 5 6 policies established by the Commission. The executives and administrators of 7 the Department shall be exempt from overtime payments as will certain 8 professional employees occupying positions specifically exempt under the 9 overtime policies established by the Commission.

For the purpose of paying overtime, any portion of Item 2 (Overtime) of 10 11 Section 2 may be transferred to and be combined with Item 1 (Salaries) in 12 Section 2 at the discretion of the Highway Commission and notice to the 13 Auditor of State and the Director of Finance and Administration. The Arkansas Highway Commission is hereby authorized to take appropriate action as necessary to restrict or reduce the operating, 13 administration, and other associated costs of the State Highway and 14 15 Transportation Department, including the Arkansas Highway Police Division, 16 for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007 2009. Provided further, that 17 the Arkansas Highway Commission is directed to furnish the Arkansas Legislative Council with an expenditure status report regarding the financial 18 19 activities of the State Highway and Transportation Department at least quarterly, beginning no later than September 30, 1989. 20

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005

SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 24 25 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 26 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 27 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 31 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

34 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

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1	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
2	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
3	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
4	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
5	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
6	
7	SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
10	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2007 is essential to the operation of
11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2007 could work irreparable harm upon the
14	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2007.
