- 19 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 20 21 the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics are, due to unforeseen circumstances, 22 insufficient for the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics to continue to 23 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will 24 provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics to 25 continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act 26 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of 27 essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared 28 to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and 29 30 after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 31
- effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
 the veto.
