15 TO CLARIFY WHEN A FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-11-405(e)(1), concerning the board of  
24 trustees of the policemen's pension and relief fund, is amended to read as  
25 follows:

26 (e)(1) Each member of the board of trustees of the policemen's pension  
27 and relief fund who receives gifts or other compensation that in total exceed  
28 one hundred dollars (\$100), including, but not limited to, trips and meals,  
29 from current or potential investment advisors or managers of the policemen's  
30 pension and relief fund shall prepare an annual statement listing:

- 31 (A) Each item received;  
32 (B) The estimated value of each item; and  
33 (C) From whom each item was received.  
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35 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-11-801(j)(1), concerning the board of



1 trustees of the firemen’s pension and relief funds, is amended to read as  
2 follows:

3 (j)(1) Each member of the board of trustees of the firemen’s pension  
4 and relief fund who receives gifts or other compensation that in total exceed  
5 one hundred dollars (\$100), including, but not limited to, trips and meals,  
6 from current or potential investment advisors or managers of the firemen’s  
7 pension and relief fund shall prepare an annual statement listing:

- 8 (A) Each item received;
- 9 (B) The estimated value of each item; and
- 10 (C) From whom each item was received.
