21	SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY The Judicial Resources Assessment Committee
22	of the Arkansas Judicial Council has reviewed the caseloads of various
23	judicial districts and has determined that to ensure the smooth, efficient,
24	and timely administration of justice an additional circuit judgeship is
25	needed in the Fourth Judicial District. This act authorizes the
26	establishment of one (1) additional circuit judgeship, articulates the
27	election process of the additional circuit judge, and identifies various
28	resources that will be available.

5	(c)(l) The additional circuit judge shall be elected from the
6	district, shall satisfy the same qualifications for holding office, and shall
7	receive the same salary, expenses, and other allowances as provided by law
8	for judges of the circuit courts.
9	(2) The circuit judge shall serve for elected terms of six (6)
10	years.
11	(d) The counties that compose the Fourth Judicial District shall
12	provide courtroom and office facilities and supplies for the judge of the
