16 TO PROVIDE THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF
17 CORRECTION MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
24

25 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-30-204(c), concerning the purchase of
26 goods by state and local agencies, is amended to read as follows:

27 (c)(1) The Department of Correction may enter into an agreement with
28 the Old State House Commission to utilize inmate labor in the production or
29 manufacture of items for resale by the Old State House Museum.

30 (2) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(3) of this section,
31 the proceeds from the sales of the items produced or manufactured under
32 subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall be used by the Old State House
33 Museum to:

34 (A) Develop exhibits and programs about the history of the
35 Department of Correction; or



1 (B) Maintain the Old State House Museum’s collection of
2 the Department of Correction artifacts.

3 (3) The Department of Correction and the commission may by rule
4 modify the use of the proceeds from the sale of items produced or
5 manufactured under subdivision (c)(1) of this section.

6 (d) All purchases made pursuant to this section shall be made through
7 the Department of Correction’s purchasing department, upon requisition by the
8 proper authority of the office, department, institution, agency, or political
9 subdivision of this state requiring the articles or products.
