13 TO MODIFY COUNTY REQUIREMENTS CONCERNING
14 CHECKS AND ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFERS.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-24-204 is amended to read as follows:

21 14-24-204. Payment generally.

22 (a)(1) It is the intent of this subchapter that, after a claim has
23 been properly presented to a county court with a proper certification and
24 itemization thereof, as provided by law, the county clerk may cause a check
25 to be prepared in payment of the claim. This check must be accompanied by an
26 attached certification from the clerk stating that the check is for payment
27 of a valid claim against the county, properly presented and allowed, as
28 provided by law, the check being presented to the county treasurer for his or
29 her signature, such check being in duplicate form, allowing for the following
30 information and distribution:

31 (A) An original check, after being transmitted to the
32 treasurer for his or her signature, will be delivered to the party presenting
33 the claim to the treasurer; and

34 (B)(i) A duplicate copy of the check, which will provide
35 the printed certification thereon by the clerk to the treasurer and provide



1 for the original signature of the clerk on the certification, will be
2 maintained *by the treasurer.*

3 *(ii) A duplicate copy of the check may be retained in electronic form*
4 *rather than paper.*

5 *(2) The checks shall be prenumbered and designed in such form*
6 *that the ~~specific appropriation applicable and~~ particular fund affected out*
7 *of which the check is to be paid is noted thereon.*

8 *(b) In lieu of the provisions of this section pertaining to the*
9 *issuance of a check in duplicate form, if a county so chooses, the following*
10 *provisions may apply:*

11 *(1) Once the aforementioned claim procedures have been*
12 *completed, the treasurer may cause a check to be prepared in payment of*
13 *claims filed with the county court;*

14 *(2) Each claim properly docketed and approved for payment by the*
15 *county court shall be proper certification from the clerk to the treasurer*
16 *that a valid claim exists; and*

17 *(3) The checks shall be prenumbered and so designed that the*
18 *~~specific appropriation applicable, particular fund affected, and claim number~~*
19 *shall be noted thereon.*

20
21 *SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-24-121 is amended to read as follows:*
22 *14-24-121. Electronic warrants transfer system.*

23 *(a) The quorum court of each county may, by ordinance, establish an*
24 *electronic warrants transfer system directly into payee's accounts in*
25 *financial institutions in payment of any account allowed against the county.*

26 *(b)(1) For purposes of this section counties opting for the electronic*
27 *warrants transfer system shall ~~not be required to follow the generally~~*
28 *~~established rules concerning the payment of county claims but may establish~~*
29 *~~their own electronic payment method provided that method follows generally~~*
30 *~~accepted accounting principles and leaves an adequate audit trail that~~*
31 *provides for internal accounting controls and documentation for audit and*
32 *accounting purposes.*

33 *(2) The electronic payment method under subdivision (b)(1) of*
34 *this section shall be approved by the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee*
35 *before implementation by the county.*

36 *(c) A single electronic warrants transfer may contain payments to*

1 *multiple payees, appropriations, characters, and funds.*
