20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
21

22 SECTION 1. Uncodified Section 4 of Act 1366 of 2003, as amended by Act
23 1823 of 2005 and Act 432 of 2007, concerning homeland security and threat
24 assessment plans, is amended to read as follows:

25 Section 4. Sunset Clause.

26 This act expires on July 1, ~~2009~~ 2011.
27

28 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
29 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1366 of 2003, as amended,
30 known as the Homeland Security Information Act, is necessary for the safety
31 and protection of the citizens of the State of Arkansas; that without
32 legislative action the Homeland Security Information Act will expire on July
33 1, 2009; and that this act is immediately necessary to prevent the expiration
34 of the act. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
35 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and



1 safety shall become effective on:

2 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

3 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
4 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
5 bill; or

6 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
7 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
