19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-1-102(a), concerning the term of office
22 for certain officers, is amended to read as follows:

23 (a)(1) The term of office of the ~~Commissioner of State Lands~~, Justices
24 of the Supreme Court, all district officers, except state senators, all
25 county officers, except members of the lower house of the General Assembly,
26 and all township officers and road overseers, when road overseers are
27 elected, shall begin on January 1 following their election.

28 (2) The term of office of the Commissioner of State Lands shall
29 begin on the same date as provided in Article 6, § 3 of the Constitution of
30 Arkansas for other constitutional officers.

31 (3) However, in the case of a
32 special election to fill an unexpired term, or to fill an office created
33 after the last preceding general election, the term of the officer so elected
34 shall begin as soon after the election as the result can be ascertained and
35 the person elected can be commissioned and qualified. **APPROVED: 3/27/2009**
