9 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC
10 BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AT
11 RESTAURANTS LOCATED IN THE SAME CITY AS A LARGE
12 ATTENDANCE FACILITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC
15 BEVERAGES FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AT
16 RESTAURANTS LOCATED IN THE SAME CITY AS

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-9-216 is amended to read as follows:

24 3-9-216. Authorization of sales on Sundays for certain large
25 attendance facilities and restaurants.

26 (a) Large attendance facilities under § 3-9-202(8)(B) in which pari-
27 mutuel wagering has been authorized and which have a valid and current
28 license or permit to sell alcoholic beverages for consumption on their
29 premises may sell alcoholic beverages on Sundays between the hours of 12:00
30 midnight and 2:00 a.m. and on Sundays between the hours of 12:00 noon and
31 2:00 a.m. on the following Monday in addition to other times authorized by
32 law for selling alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises.

33 (b) A restaurant under § 3-9-202(8)(A) may sell alcoholic beverages
34 for on-premises consumption on Sundays between the hours of 12:00 midnight
35 and 2:00 a.m. and on Sundays between the hours of 12:00 noon and 2:00 a.m. on



1 the following Monday in addition to other times authorized by law for selling
2 alcoholic beverages for on-premises consumption if the restaurant:

3 (1) Is located in the same city as a large attendance facility
4 authorized to sell liquor for on-premises consumption on Sundays under
5 subsection (a) of this section; and

6 (2) Has a valid and current license or permit to sell alcoholic
7 beverage for on-premises consumption.

8 (c) This section shall not be construed to:

9 (1) Authorize the sale of alcoholic beverages in any city or
10 county or in any portion of a city or county in which the sale of alcoholic
11 beverages is prohibited by law; or

12 (2) Repeal or modify any law that prohibits the sale of
13 intoxicating alcoholic liquor, beer, or wine on Sunday unless the law
14 specifically conflicts with this section.
