19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 7, Chapter 7, Subchapter 3 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 7-7-313. Unopposed races.

24 If there is a primary election in which only one (1) candidate has
25 filed for the position by a filing deadline and there are no other ballot
26 issues to be submitted for consideration, the county board of election
27 commissioners may reduce the number of polling places or open no polling
28 places on election day so that the election is conducted by absentee ballot
29 and early voting only.
