

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6 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. 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21 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 22 FUND 23 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 24 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 25 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 26 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 27 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 28 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 29 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 30 31 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 32 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 33 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. 34 35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 36 2010 through June 30, 2009 2011.

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2 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 3 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 5 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 8 9 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 10 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 11 with in disbursement of said funds.

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13 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 14 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 15 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 16 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 17 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 18 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 19 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 20 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

22 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 24 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 25 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2010 is essential to the operation of 26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2010 could work irreparable harm 28 29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 31 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2010. 32 33 34 35
