LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the 18 General Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the 19 operations of the Department of Arkansas State Police are, due to unforeseen 20 circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Arkansas State Police to continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of 21 22 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Department of Arkansas 23 State Police to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective 24 date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration 25 and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is 26 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate 27 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 28 29 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 30 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 31 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 32 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 33 the veto. 34
