9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS
11 STATE UNIVERSITY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS
12 FOR MEDICAL SCIENCES WHICH SHALL BE SUPPLEMENTAL
13 AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS APPROPRIATED BY
14 ACTS 579 AND 831 OF 2009; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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18 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY
19 AND THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS FOR
20 MEDICAL SCIENCES SUPPLEMENTAL
21 APPROPRIATION.
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS BIOSCIENCES INSTITUTE. There is hereby
27 appropriated, to the Arkansas State University, to be payable from the
28 Arkansas Biosciences Institute Program Account, for personal services and
29 operating expenses of the Arkansas State University - Arkansas Biosciences
30 Institute which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
31 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 579 of 2009, the following:

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8 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH. There is hereby
9 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences, to be
10 payable from the Targeted State Needs Program Account of the Tobacco
11 Settlement Program Fund, for personal services of the University of Arkansas
12 for Medical Sciences - College of Public Health which shall be supplemental
13 and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 831 of 2009,
14 the following:

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20 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
21 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMPLIANCE WITH
22 OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to
23 the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the
24 support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement
25 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
26 Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, the
27 Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or their successors, and
28 other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations
29 promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by
30 law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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32 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE
33 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEGISLATIVE
34 INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed
35 under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in
36 compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as

1 evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative
2 Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of
3 Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the
4 official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
5 Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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7 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
9 the Arkansas State University and the University of Arkansas for Medical
10 Sciences are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas
11 State University and the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to
12 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of
13 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas State University
14 and the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences to continue such
15 services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work
16 irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
17 governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
18 and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19 peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the
20 date of its passage and approval.

21 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
22 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
23 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
24 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
25 the veto.
