#### Abstract

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE CHILD ABUSE HOTLINE TO ACCEPT REPORTS OF INJURY TO A CHILD'S INTELLECTUAL, EMOTIONAL, OR PSYCHOLOGICAL DEVELOPMENT FROM A GUIDANCE COUNSELOR LICENSED AS A TEACHER.


## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-18-308 is amended to read as follows:
12-18-308. Reports of injury to a child's intellectual, emotional, or psychological development.

The Child Abuse Hotline shall accept a report of injury to a child's intellectual, emotional, or psychological development as evidenced by observable and substantial impairment of the child's ability to function within the child's normal range of performance and behavior only if the reporter is:
(1) A medical or mental health professional;
(2) A school counselor, if the child did not disclose to the

## teacher;

(2) (3) A teacher; or
$(3)(4)$ A day care center worker.
