17 18 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. RATE OF PAY. The entry level salary of a trial court staff person shall be equal to that established in the state pay plan at grade C117.

21 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

23 CERTIFICATION. Any Trial Court Administrative Assistant who is or becomes

24 certified by the National Center for State Courts as a certified Court

Manager shall be entitled to have the annual salary for which he or she is eligible to be increased by ten percent (10%), which shall not exceed the

27 maximum amount for the grade assigned.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2010}{100}$ 2011 through June 30, $\frac{2011}{100}$.

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SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal

1	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by			
2	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be			
3	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

5	SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General			
6	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations			
7	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for			
8	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive			
9	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget			
10	anuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or			
11	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative			
12	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.			
13				
14	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General			
15	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the			
16	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the			
17	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of			
18	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in			
19	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the			
20	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm			
21	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental			
22	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act			
23	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health			
24	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011.
