21	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - VETERINARY MEDICINE LOAN FORGIVENESS		
24	PROGRAM. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education,		
25	to be payable from the Higher Education Grants Fund Account, for forgivable		
26	tuition loans to eligible Arkansas students attending out-of-state veterinary		
27	medicine schools and who practice food supply veterinary medicine in the		
28	State, in compliance	with Arkansas law, by the Department of	Higher Education
29	for the fiscal year e	nding June 30, 2012, the sum of	\$120,000.

31	SECTION 2. COMP	LIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of	f funds
32	authorized by this ac	t shall be limited to the appropriation	for such agency
33	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and		
34	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and		
35	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary		
36	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal		



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1 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 2 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 3 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 5 6 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 7 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 8 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 9 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 10 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 11 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 12 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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14 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 15 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 16 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 17 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2011 is essential to the operation of 18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 19 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 20 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2011 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 21 22 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 23 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 24 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2011. 25 26 27 APPROVED: 04/01/2011 28

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
