22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-16-805(b)(1), regarding identification
25 cards, is amended to read as follows:

26 (b)(1)(A) For those persons under sixty (60) years of age, the card
27 shall be valid for either four (4) years or two (2) years, depending on the
28 person's age, and is renewable upon expiration.

29 (B) For persons fourteen (14) years of age and older, the
30 card shall be valid for four (4) years from the date of issue.

31 (C) For persons five (5) to thirteen (13) years of age,
32 the card shall be valid for two (2) years from the date of issue, and a
33 parent, ~~or~~ legal guardian, grandparent, or sibling over eighteen (18) years
34 of age must accompany the applicant to the issuing location and sign the
35 electronic application.
