10	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
11	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the		
12	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System statutes are badly in need of revision and		
13	updating to bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy;		
14	that this revision and updating is of great importance to members of the		
15	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and to other citizens of the State of		
16	Arkansas; that the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System operates on a July 1 to		
17	June 30 fiscal year so most changes to the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System
