1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-7-303(b), concerning the general duties		
2	of the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System, is		
3	amended to read as follows:		
4	(b) $\underline{(1)}$ The trustees shall serve as trustees without compensation for		
5	their services as such, except that:		
6	(A) each Each trustee may receive expense reimbursement in		
7	accordance with § 25-16-901 et seq.		
8	(B) The system shall reimburse a trustee for reasonable expenses		
9	incurred in the performance of his or her duties as trustee, including		
10	without limitation, the cost of:		
11	(i) A substitute teacher for a trustee;		
12	(ii) Communication services required for paperless		
13	board meetings.		
14	(2) Trustees are authorized to attend all system committee		
15	meetings, board meetings, and other official system functions without		
16	negative impact on his or her employment status.

18	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
19	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that provisions of the Arkansas		
20	Teacher Retirement System statutes are in urgent need of revision to bring		
21	them into conformance with sound public pension policy; that this revision is		
22	of great importance to members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and		
23	to other citizens of the State of Arkansas; that when an unexpected vacancy		
24	occurs in a trustee position, the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher		
25	Retirement System must be able to appoint a trustee until a special election		
26	is called; that trustees are called away from their regular job duties and		
27	responsibilities to attend system board meetings and should be encouraged to		
28	attend and accommodated in their attendance to fulfill their elected board		
29	functions; and that this act is immediately necessary in order to maintain an		
30	orderly system of benefits for members of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement		
31	System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being		
32	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall		
33	become effective on:		
34	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
35	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
36	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		

1	bill; or
2	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
3	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
